

Well racers, the folks at Lebanon Valley have been busy and have converted the track back from boat races to be able to host our Fall Drag Day! For those of you that don't know, the track had its share of rain and the result was several feet of water on (over?) the property, including the track itself. The staff has done an excellent job of pumping out and cleaning up.

So, it's time to plan on coming to our Fall Drag Day, Friday, Sept. 25, 2009. The rain date is Thursday, Oct. 1. As mentioned before, Friday rain dates are no longer available since the track is booked up for Friday rentals through the end of the season. We may have been responsible in part for the popularity of track rentals as a result of the article about us in Hemmings Muscle Machines magazine a while back. Hey, it helps to keep the track financially healthy and that's good for all of us. to be announced.

We'll be handling the roster the same way as the last rental. To refresh your memory - you must send a deposit check to me for \$30 along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The checks are to be made out to "LVD". You will receive by return mail a receipt for your deposit. The receipt will be numbered and signed by an authorized LVD person. Once you get the receipt, it's yours. If you can't make the date, it will be up to you to find a replacement and give the receipt to that person. The receipt must be presented at the tower office when you sign in and pay the remaining \$40 of the rental fee. If, and only if, we are rained out on both the primary date and the rain date, you'll be able to use the receipt for any regular Wednesday Street Night/Test & Tune, any regular Saturday Test & Tune, or any Sunday Test & Tune/Open Trophy at LVD. The receipt cannot be used for special events like Musclepalooza. We will no longer hold deposits over till the next rental. You can have two drivers (not 3, 4, etc.) with one car for a single entry fee. You can no longer have one driver with two cars as in the past.

I'll be getting the rental receipts from LVD soon and will mail them out to all who have sent in deposits. The roster is already 1/4 full so don't procrastinate if you want to run.



The September meeting will be hosted by Jean Roy on Thursday September 10th.


